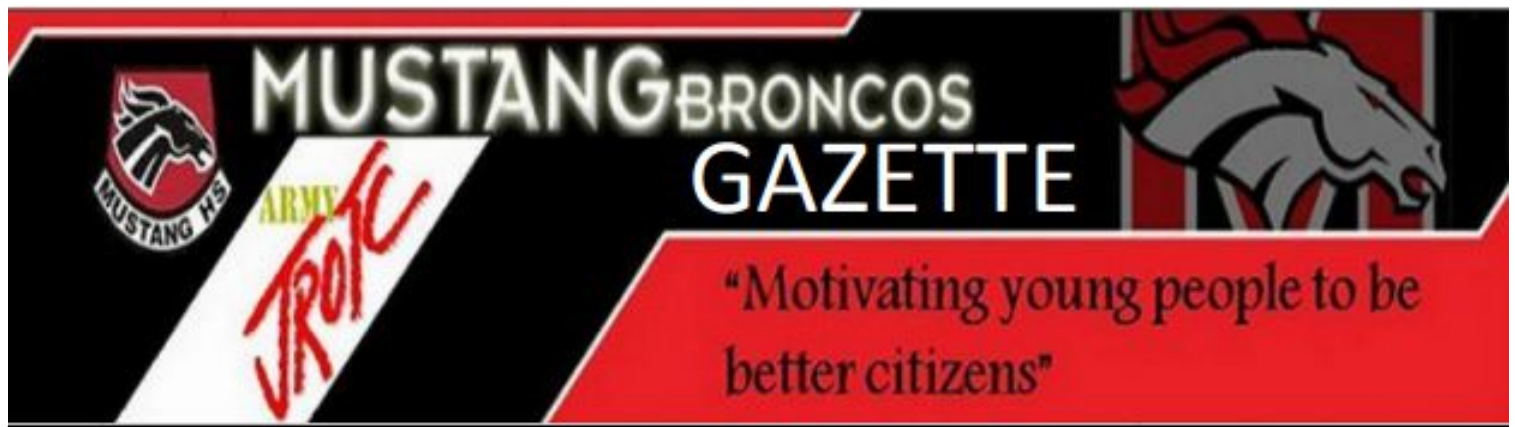
Follow Us For Updates
