

**MUSTANG HIGH SCHOOL ARMY JROTC MARKSMANSHIP CLASS**  
**Competitive Marksmanship Class Syllabus (School Year 2019-20)**

PRIMARY INSTRUCTOR - CW4 OMAR A. JONES

**Justification:** The three-position marksmanship event (prone, standing and kneeling) is an official Olympic medal event, on the same level as wrestling, cross-country, basketball and track and field events. Over 200 full four year college scholarships are offered annually to qualified graduating high school marksman. The class meets during 4th period in the drill hall of the JROTC facility.

**Grade level:** 10 -12. (Instructor approval required)

**Class Composition:** Limited to a maximum of 16 students, (15 firers and 1 student safety officer)

**Course Length:** Year.

**Curriculum:** The curriculum/lesson plans are part of Unit 7 of the Army JROTC Program of Instruction (POI). Certification and accreditation is through the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) and the U.S. Army Cadet Command.

**Prerequisite:** Successful completion of LET I and enrolled as a LET II, III, or IV JROTC student, exceptions may be granted on case by Case basis. Student is required to pass/complete all CMP and Cadet Command requirements before they are allowed on the marksmanship range. This class is the varsity team. Students must be academically eligible to participate in any and/or all competitions. Any student who continuously fails to maintain academic eligibility will be removed from the class at the end of the semester. This activity is a competitive sport and will require time spent outside of the regular school day.

**Grading:** 25% - Test & Quizzes and 75% - Weekly Marksmanship Scores

Test Scores are derived from written and competition scoring, in the event that the cadet does not qualify to travel with the team their score will come from the average of the highest scoring team. Weekly Score is based on the best total score of the best set of targets (Prone, Knelling and Standing) shot for that week.
