1. **Compare** - Tell how things are alike; All the ways two or more things are alike;
2. **Contrast** - Tell how things are different; The state of being noticeably different from something else when put or considered together.
3. **Define** - Give a clear, specific meaning of a term or an object
4. **Describe** - Tell how something looks, sounds and feels
5. **Diagram** - Explain using lines, a web, or another graphic organizer
6. **Evaluate** - Give your opinion about the value of a topic; Rate, grade, score or judge it.
7. **Explain** - Tell what something means or how something works
8. **Identify** - Answer the 5 W's and H about a topic (Who, What, When, Where, Why, & How)
9. **Illustrate** - Show how something works by using examples
10. **Prove** - Present facts that show something is true
11. **Review** - Give an overall picture of a topic
12. **Summarize** - Tell just the key information about a topic; say it in fewer words without losing the meaning
13. **Support** - Back it up, prove it, give me the reasons, give me some facts.
14. **Trace** - Follow up, step-by-step, from the beginning to the end, list the steps;
15. **Analyze** - Take it apart, tell me the good and the bad, break it down; , Break down in order to bring out the essential elements or structure; To identify parts, relationships, and interpret information to reach conclusions.
16. **Infer** - Read between the lines, make an educated guess, what do you think they are really trying to say; A conclusion one can draw from the presented details.
17. **Formulate** - Come up with, make a plan, develop, make, create, Come up with, build, show me in words what it means.
18. **Predict** - Give me your best guess, look ahead and tell me what you think will happen.; to say what will happen in the future, often using reason and experience.
